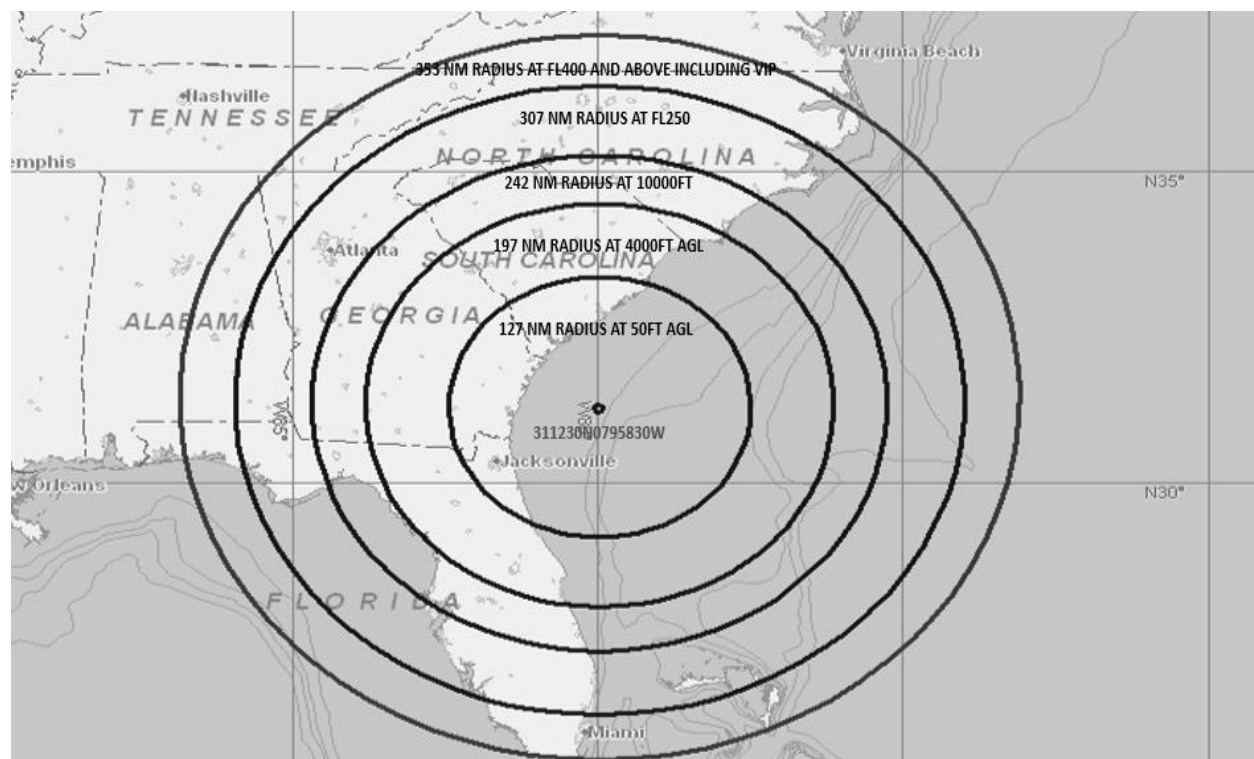
Off the coast of Savannah, GA

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 311230N0795830W or the SAV VORTAC 139-degree radial at 84NM.
- B. Dates and times:

3 DEC 17	1300Z – 1800Z
7 DEC 17	1300Z – 1800Z
- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV (CSG4 GPS 17-06) GPS (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 353 NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 311230N0795830W (SAV 139084) FL400-UNL,
307 NM RADIUS AT FL250
242 NM RADIUS AT 10000FT
197 NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL
127 NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
