FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TRAINING

GVTX 18-26 (Greeneville, Texas)

20 April – 23 May 2018 Greeneville, TX

GPS training is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 330354N0960318W or the BYP VORTAC 160-degree radial at 30NM.
- B. Dates and times:

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (GVTX 18-26) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 343NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 330354N0960318W (BPY160030) FL400-UNL, 301NM RADIUS AT FL250, 244NM RADIUS AT 10000FT, 210NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL, 190NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS interference training activities.
