GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 641819N1461800W or the BIG VORTAC 302-degree radial at 24NM.

B. Dates and times:


26 APR – 12 MAY 18	0000Z – 0300Z	1800Z – 2359Z
13 – 20 MAY 18	0600Z – 1600Z	

C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (JFAK GPS 18-02) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 525NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 641819N1461800W (BIG 302024) FL400-UNL, 475NM RADIUS AT FL250 437NM RADIUS AT 10000FT 371NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL 349NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.

E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
