## FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

## AIR FORCE SPECTRUM MANAGEMENT OFFICE (AFSMO) 18-03

## 26 February – 06 March 2018 Denver, Colorado

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 410700N1040205W or the CYS VORTAC 092-degree radial at 34NM.
- B. Dates and times:

26 FEB – 02 MAR 18	0630Z - 0900Z
05 – 06 MAR 18	0630Z - 0900Z

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (AFSMO GPS 18-03) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 320NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 410700N1040205W (CYS092034) FL400-UNL, 270NM RADIUS AT FL250
  194NM RADIUS AT FL250
  194NM RADIUS AT 10000FT
  166NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL
  158NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
