GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

A. Location: Centered at 470259N1103758W or the GTF VOR 115-degree radial at 40NM.

B. Dates and times:

26 FEB – 02 MAR 18	1631Z – 2000Z
05 – 06 MAR 18	1631Z – 2000Z

C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (AFSMO GPS 18-04) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 361NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 470259N1103758W (GTF115040) FL400-UNL, 302NM RADIUS AT FL250 222NM RADIUS AT 10000FT 213NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL 162NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.

E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.
