FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

AIR FORCE SPECTRUM MANAGEMENT OFFICE (AFSMO) 18-07

26 February – 06 March 2018 Washington, DC

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 384821N0765216W or the EMI VORTAC 184-degree radial at 42NM.
- B. Dates and times:

26 FEB – 02 MAR 18 0400Z – 0600Z 05 – 06 MAR 18 0400Z – 0600Z

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (AFSMO GPS 18-07) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 266NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 384821N0765216W (EMI184042) FL400-UNL, 219NM RADIUS AT FL250 153NM RADIUS AT 10000FT 119NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL 82NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
