## FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

## AIR FORCE SPECTRUM MANAGEMENT OFFICE (AFSMO) 18-21

## 26 February – 06 March 2018 Charleston, SC

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 325352N0800313W or the CHS VORTAC 293-degree radial at 1NM.
- B. Dates and times:

26 – 28 FEB 18 1300Z – 1500Z 01 – 02 MAR 18 1001Z – 1259Z 05 – 06 MAR 18 1001Z – 1259Z

- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (AFSMO GPS 18-21) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 252NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 325352N0800313W (CHS293001) FL400-UNL, 206NM RADIUS AT FL250 139NM RADIUS AT 10000FT 96NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL 38NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
