FLIGHT ADVISORY GPS INTERFERENCE TESTING

CARRIER STRIKE GROUP FOUR (CSG4) 21-05 Revision 1

31 March – 1 April 2021 Off-The-Coast, VA

GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 365600N0762000W or the ORF VOR 298 degree radial at 7NM.
- B. Dates and times (Dates and times are based on GMT (Z).):


31 MAR – 1 APR 21 DLY 1400Z -2000Z

C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.

NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (CSG4 GPS 21-05) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 221NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 365600N0762000W (ORF298007) FL400-UNL, 177NM RADIUS AT FL250, 116NM RADIUS AT 10000FT, 79NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL, 25NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.

D. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies in accordance with the Aeronautical Information Manual (AIM) paragraphs 1-1-13 and 5-3-3.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
