TRIPLE TREE AERODROME (SC00) ANNOUNCES NEW ADVISORY PROCEDURES FOR RUNWAY 03

(Woodruff, SC) – Triple Tree Aerodrome announced a change in their advisory procedures regarding Runway 03.

In the exclusive interest of safety, a quorum of individuals representing Triple Tree Aerodrome, with guidance from the National Aviation Safety Foundation and the Federal Aviation Administration, have made the decision to modify the useable length of Runway 03 at Triple Tree.

The trees on the South end of the Enoree River (which flanks the bottom end of Triple Tree's runway) have grown to a height that creates a visual obstruction for approximately the first 1,000 feet of Runway 03. As a result, this may pose a safety risk for landing and departing traffic on Runway 03.

The trees are on property that cannot be maintained by Triple Tree. As a result, Triple Tree Aerodrome's advisory procedures have been changed to restrict approximately the first 1,000 feet of Runway 03 from normal operations. Though, this restricted area will still be maintained for emergency use.

Pilots flying in and out of Triple Tree (SC00) are encouraged to regularly review Triple Tree's advisory procedures at www.tta.aero/pilot-information.
