## VFR TRANSITION THROUGH CHICAGO APPROACH

- 14. Pilots are urged to use the VFR FLYWAY PLANNING CHART for the Chicago area.
- 15. Class Bravo clearances for VFR aircraft not available.
- 16. VFR services at or above 5500:
  - a. North of ORD 125.0 128.57
  - b. South of ORD 126.62
- 17. ORD arrivals enter Chicago airspace between 9000 and 12000 feet. VFR overflights strongly encouraged to receive flight following.
- 18. Aircraft transiting the shoreline MDW ATIS 132.75. If MDW landing 22L, jet traffic crosses shoreline at 3000 feet. Pilots urged to remain below MDW Class C airspace.
- 19. The floor of the west side Class Bravo is 4000 feet. Use caution for jet traffic level at 4000 feet.
- 20. Caution heavy parachute activity near 8N2 and RPJ at or below 14,500'MSL
